PACKING LIST:

ESSENTIALS:

- Passport, with a minimum validity of 6 months
- 100 US\$ in cash to pay the Galapagos national park entrance fee when arriving in Galapagos
- Suitcase, travel bag, or backpack
- Small daypack or a waist-belt style hiking pack for water bottle, sun cream, camera, etc
- Money in cash, credit cards, (PINS!) Codes to access accounts, email, etc.
- Documents/copy of your travel documents, insurance, and the most important emergency contact numbers
- Enough waterproof bags for the camera, cell phone, etc
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CLOTHES:

- Fast-drying pants, comfortable shorts (ideal with side pockets for cell phone storage), sundress, T-shirts, leggings, and a light sweater for evening lounging on board.
- Fleece (make sure to have it on your cabin luggage for the flight), rain jacket
- Light night suit(s)
- 2 bathing/swimsuits or bikini
- Underwear, socks, comfortable bras
- Optional: your wetsuit
- Optional: your snorkel gear (especially your mask if you use lenses with measures or your full-face mask)
- Optional: your snorkel gear (mainly mask if you have special glasses)
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FOOTWEAR:

- Closed-toed, water-safe trekking sandals like Keen, Teva, etc
- Tennis shoes/sneakers for volcanic terrain
- Flip flop or slippers as house shoes on board if you won't be barefoot
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SUN PROTECTION & TOILETRIES:

- Sunscreen, sunscreen for lips, after-sun
- Lightweight hat (!)
- T-shirt or blouse for snorkeling
- Sunglasses
- Toothbrush & toothpaste Razor, deodorant, and others
- Personal toiletries, hairbrush, etc.
- Wet season (Feb-Jun): mosquito repellent
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
